Take Control & RMT Motorcycle Training

Take Control is a post test skills course that is part funded by the Safer Roads Partnership in West Mercia with the support of NHS Worcestershire, Public Health and The TTC Group.

The Take Control course is delivered by RMT Motorcycle Training.

What is a Take Control course?

It is an on-road skills enhancement course that assesses your current riding ability and identifies areas of improvement, to make you a better, more confident and competent road rider.

Learner riders must have passed their CBT (Compulsory Basic Training).

Why would I want to do the course?

You may feel that you are a good enough rider already but over time may have fallen into bad habits and could do with a rider health check to enhance your skills. All riders can benefit from a refresher course to assess and improve how they are using the road. We will ensure you change your riding outlook to minimise the risk on today's busy and congested roads.

Who is it aimed at & who is eligible?

This course is open to all riders who have a passion to be a better rider. It does not matter what type of moped, scooter or motorcycle you ride, as long as you live in Herefordshire, Worcestershire or Shropshire, and are interested in improving your skills to get the most out of your riding.

You must be over the age of 16 years and own your own moped, scooter or motorbike and have adequate protective clothing. Moped riders must have passed their CBT (Compulsory Basic Training).

Radio communication equipment is supplied for the duration of the course.

Skills & benefits of the course:

- Braking techniques.
- Counter steering help and advice.
- Risk management tuition and guidance.
- Enhanced riding skills (to help towards your ERS certificate).
- Insurance discounts when you complete the Enhanced Rider Scheme.
- Greater handling skills and safer riding style.

What does the course cover & how is it delivered?

- The course starts at 0900 and finishes at approximately 1600.
- An initial discussion about areas for improvement and the new skills you would like to learn.
- Riding assessment and action plan during the first road ride session.
- Guidance, tuition and remedial action including road and theory work.
- Practice and development riding ensuring you understand how to develop and improve.
- Final debrief, appraisal and discussion on the next stage of riding development.

What happens after this course?

After completing your training on a larger motorbike you may feel that you would like to take your skills to the next level and there are many options open to you for further training. RMT Motorcycle Training will give you an action plan following the Take Control course to identify the areas you need to work on.

Where possible, we will start a portfolio on each rider to start the Enhanced Rider Scheme training to allow you to be eligible for significant insurance discounts.
